

- You may be asked to undertake additional work in your own time to support your learning
- As well as submitting regular excerpts from their novels, the students will be expected to complete a synopsis and covering letter in their own time.

What kind of feedback can I expect from the tutor?

- You will be encouraged to share your work with the group and discuss your learning
- You will be encouraged to consider other students work and give your opinions and suggestions
- You will feedback every week on what you feel you have learnt/achieved in the session.

What else do I need to know? Is there anything I need to bring?

- A pen and notebook is necessary. A course file will be useful to keep your work and handouts from the sessions.
