

4. Demonstrate an understanding of how languages can be invented or adapted for secret purposes.

What teaching methods will be used and will there be work outside of the class?

- The WEA tutor will use a range of different teaching and learning methods and encourage you and the group to be actively involved in your learning
- The tutor will sometimes suggest you prepare for a subsequent class, but written work outside the class will not be required.

What kind of feedback can I expect from the tutor?

- You will have opportunities to discuss your progress with your tutor
- Various activities will take place during the classes to help you learn and the tutor to assess how you are learning.

What else do I need to know? Is there anything I need to bring?

- Nothing else is needed
- Especially later in the course, you will be encouraged to bring materials (e.g. examples of codes) to the class, but this will never be required.

Pre-course work, reading and information sources

- No pre reading is required but research on the subject on the internet or in the library may be helpful

Possible next steps after this course including career opportunities if appropriate

- Progress to another WEA course
- Progress to a course with another provider
- The subject-matter of the course overlaps with various other areas, particularly linguistics, and it may prove helpful to anyone planning to learn about them.
