5. 5 Demonstrate various methods to print, resist with batik, shibori dye and cold water dye to rejuvenate old clothes

### **What teaching methods will be used and will there be work outside of the class?**

- The WEA tutor will use a range of different teaching and learning methods and encourage you and the group to be actively involved in your learning
