- Although it's not compulsory to carry our work outside the class, you will make much faster progress if you can do so.

What kind of feedback can I expect from the tutor?

- You will have opportunities to discuss your progress with your tutor
- You will be encouraged to share your work with the group and discuss your learning
- You will be encouraged to consider other students work and give your opinions and suggestions
- You will receive continuous feedback on your progress from the tutor. You are encouraged to use a notebook for record keeping.

What else do I need to know? Is there anything I need to bring?

- We have a good selection of specialised tools, but you are encouraged to bring your own if you have them. Materials are not included in the course fee, but the tutor can advise on obtaining them.

Pre-course work, reading and information sources

- No pre reading is required but research on the subject on the internet or in the library may be helpful
- "The Art of Violin Making" by Courtnall and Johnson is an excellent book which is strongly recommended. There are also some valuable internet resources, but the tutor should be consulted about their relative merits.
