

1. Demonstrate in discussion an understanding of the way that the Romans left Britain.
2. Demonstrate the confidence to have an opinion about who the Britons and Anglo Saxons were.
3. Participate in discussion of why the settlement at Castleford changed in the Dark Ages.
4. Participate in discussion of the presentation of the Dark Ages or Early Medieval period in the local museum.
5. Recognise the evidence for and against a mass movement of Anglo Saxon people to Yorkshire.

What teaching methods will be used and will there be work outside of the class?

- The WEA tutor will use a range of different teaching and learning methods and encourage you and the group to be actively involved in your learning
- We will visit the local history museum at Castleford Museum. This is free and is a short walk from the Queen's Mill.

What kind of feedback can I expect from the tutor?

- You will have opportunities to discuss your progress with your tutor
