

What will I achieve?**By the end of the course I will be able to:**

1. Speak to people I don't know with greater confidence.
2. Use my English with greater confidence in stressful situations such as job interviews.
3. Understand people better in conversations.
4. Speak with greater confidence about my opinions.
5. Feel confident enough to try my English in new situations such as volunteering.

What teaching methods will be used and will there be work outside of the class?

- The WEA tutor will use a range of different teaching and learning methods and encourage you and the group to be actively involved in your learning
- You will be asked to try out conversational activities in your free time to help you build your confidence.

What kind of feedback can I expect from the tutor?

- A range of informal activities will be used by the tutor to see what you are learning which may include quizzes, question and answer, small projects and discussion
- You will have opportunities to discuss your progress with your tutor
- You will be encouraged to share your work with the group and discuss your learning

What else do I need to know? Is there anything I need to bring?

- A selection of materials and basic equipment will be provided but you are welcome to bring additional materials with you
- It would be helpful if you had access to the internet (Mobile phone, tablet or computer at home or through a library etc.)
