This course is open to all (including those with disabilities), but offers an excellent introduction to the techniques of drawing and painting. The projects include: drawing techniques, working with colour, landscape painting and still life/portraiture and abstract design.

1. Produce an abstract design using a range of colours and shapes.
2. Produce a portrait or still life drawing or painting.
3. Produce a landscape drawing or painting using a range of techniques and colours.
4. Experiment confidently with art techniques for enjoyment.
